

CHATEAU LANGLET 2020

AOP Graves Blanc

~ Background ~

Located in the Cabanac-Villagrains commune, within the canton of La Brède, Château Langlet is one of the oldest vineyards of the Graves region. It was noted in the 1868 edition of "Bordeaux et Ses Vins", published by Féret, for both its red and white graves wines.

Château Langlet is owned by the Kressman family, owners of the renowned Château Latour-Martillac in Pessac Léognan. The same winemaking team of Latour-Martillac is in charge of Château Langlet.

This is a boutique property with a planted surface of 5.1 hectares. The estate employs traditional cultivation and vinification methods to produce outstanding, reasonably priced wines that still unknown in North America.

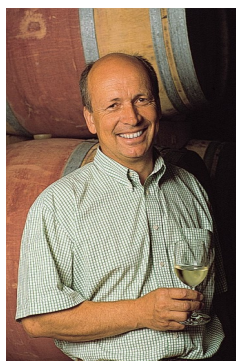
Château Langlet has 55 hectares of certified PEFC (Program For the Endorsement of Forest Certification) forest. This standard promotes a balance between the environmental, societal and economic dimensions of the forest through guarantees of sustainable practices.

In 2019 the estate was certified HEV (High Environmental Value) at the third scale.



~ Viticulture ~

- 100% Sauvignon Blanc.
- 1.5 hectares.
- Small gravel soils from the tertiary period covered by clay and sand.
- Pruning: Double Guyot
- Average vine age of 10 years.
- Density of 5500 vines/hectare.
- Yield of 45 hl/hectare.
- Sustainable agricultural practices.
- Debudding, leaf thinning, and green harvest to produce the best possible grapes.
- Manual harvest.
- Harvest date: August 24th.

- Grapes sorted manually.
- Vinification by parcel.
- Alcoholic fermentation in stainless steel vats.
- Aged 6 months in stainless steel vats.
- No filtering. Fining.
- 6,200 bottles produced.
- ABV: 13.5°C

90 Points. Owned by the Kressmann family since 1999, this estate is in the northern Graves, close to Bordeaux city. The intense herbal character and tight texture promise a balanced ripeness that will come through as the wine softens. Drink now.

~ Tasting Notes ~

This wine, with a very pale yellow color, expresses aromas of fresh citrus fruits, such as pink grapefruit, as well as exotic fruits, such as pineapple. The mouth is generous, greedy, and characterized by a nice sweetness, leading to a nice length.
