## CHATEAU ROC DE SEGUR 2021 AOP Bordeaux

### — Background —

Château Roc de Segur is located in Landerrouet sur Ségur, in the eastern part of the Entre Deux Mers appellation. The property was purchased and the vineyard planted by Gisèle and Daniel Vidal in 1992. The stones of this beautiful area of our region were used in the 18th century to build the magnificent city of Bordeaux, leaving many quarries in the village. Thus, the cellars are built directly inside the rocks. This enables a perfect ageing, providing both strength and refinement to the wine. The Vidal family has made significant investments in their facilities year after year, and they continue to improve their product with each vintage.

### — Viticulture —

- **67% Merlot, 26% Cabernet Sauvignon, 7% Cabernet Franc**
- 37 hectares of vines
- Yield of 32 hl/hectare.
- Average age of the vine is 30 years.
- Clay limestone topsoil with a part mainly oriented to the Southwest.
- Harvest is done manually.
- 4000 per hectare vine density.

### — Winemaking —

- Thermo-regulated stainless steel tanks for 20 days.
- Micro-oxygenation in tank.
- Malo-lactic fermentation in tanks
- Bottled at the chateau.

### — Tasting Notes —

Château Roc de Segur is supple and fruity, with a pleasant nose. The palate is round and well structured with silky tannins, which will evolve favorably with age. Deep aroma of red fruit mingled with spices of licorice and black currant. An extremely well balanced and elegant wine.
