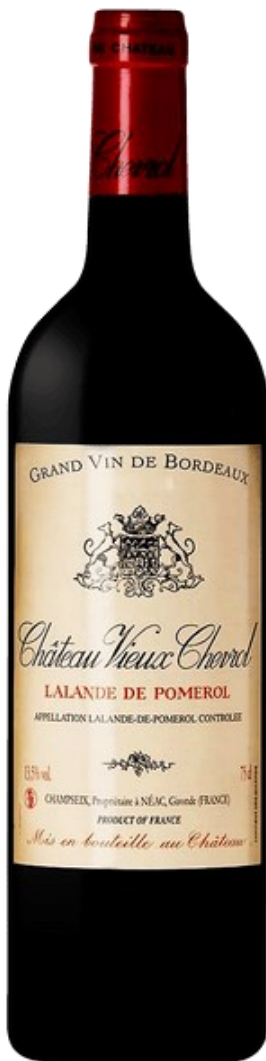

## CHATEAU VIEUX CHEVROL 2019 AOP Lalande de Pomerol



### — Background —

Château Vieux Chevrol is a small estate perched on top of a hill with a view over Pomerol plateau. Neighboring of Petrus and Cheval Blanc, Vieux Chevrol benefits from a gravelly clay terroir and produces a magnificent wine similar in quality to its prestigious neighbours. This 3rd generation owned estate and wine maker, Michel Champseix, understand the value of tradition and is dedicated to sustainable practices.

### — Viticulture —

- 21 hectares of vine
- Soil: 80 % of the vineyard is on acid clay terroir of the plateau de Néac, and 20 % of the vineyard is on gravels.
- Average age of the vines: 35 years
- **Blend: 80% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Franc & 10% Cabernet Sauvignon**

### — Winemaking —

- Manual Harvest
- Traditionnal vinifications in thermos-regulated stainless steel vats
- Ageing 12 months in demi-muids (600-litre French oak barrels)
- Production: 140 000 bottles

### —Tasting Notes—

A smooth and elegant tannin structure, which begins with dark complex fruits with characters of cassis, blackberries and black cherries. Ending with a long finish of warm spices and unforgettable cinnamon, licorice and white pepper.



**91-92 Points.** A pretty, finely crafted red with plum and dark-chocolate aromas and flavors. It has a dried-fruit undertone with hints of cedar and figs. It's medium-bodied with round, fine tannins and a delicious finish. From organically grown grapes.
